

Historic Productivity Milestone at the Port of Hong Kong

In the week of 28 April 2025, the Hong Kong Seaport Alliance (HKSPA) has set a new productivity record by deploying 10 quay cranes to manage the 366-metre **OOCL Egypt** during a large-scale transshipment operation that also involved the 399-metre *OOCL Scandinavia*.

This milestone marks the first time a single vessel has been serviced with such capacity at Hong Kong Port, showcasing its world-class capabilities and reinforcing its role as a key transshipment hub.

The operation successfully handled around 12,000 containers, equivalent to more than 20,500 TEU, within 70 hours. The simultaneous unloading and loading of containers—termed “Hot Connection”—enabled *OOCL Scandinavia* to expedite its schedule at other ports.

This achievement further enhances Hong Kong’s competitive edge as a vital catch-up port, highlighting the Port’s operational efficiency and commitment to delivering exceptional value to customers.
